


About GUST



Tuition Fee and Accommodation Fee

Tuition fee: RMB 34,800

Accommodation fee: RMB 7,800

Living Cost and Others

Application Fee: RMB 2,000 –non-refundable (can be deducted from tuition or accommodation fee upon enrollment)


Estimated living costs: Around RMB 1,500 per month, subject to personal circumstances.

Other expenses: Insurance, medical examination, and related personal costs are self-funded.

Scholarship

- **First Prize Scholarship:** covers full tuition and accommodation fee.
- **Second Prize Scholarship:** covers full tuition fee.
- **Third Prize Scholarship:** covers 50% of the tuition fee.

HOW TO APPLY

Requirements

- Non-Chinese citizens in good health, with no criminal record, strong academic performance, and a demonstrated ability to learn and innovate.
- Applicants must have completed high school or hold an equivalent qualification and be aged between 18 and 35.

Application Materials

Required for Admission

- Application Form
- Passport Scanned Copy
- ID Photo
- Non-Criminal Record
- Health Examination Report
- Diploma & Transcript: Highest diploma or pre-graduation certificate with transcripts. Notarized translations are required if documents are not in Chinese, English, or Russian.

Additional Materials for Scholarship Consideration

- **Motivation Letter:** A short statement (about 500 words) describing your interest in Chinese language and culture, your study goals, and why you chose this program. This letter is primarily used for scholarship evaluation.
- **Recommendation Letter:** One letter in Chinese, English, or Russian, including full contact information, dated after March 1, 2025.
